1 INTRODUCTION

The basic website of the project has been launched mid-June 2019, less than 30 days after the project's start, in M1, in accordance to the Grant Agreement. The website was conceived to support the launch of the project, providing an overview of the project and information about the partners involved.

The final version of the website is yet to be designed and launched before December 2019 (M6) and will include more detailed information about the project's objectives, approach and dissemination material.

This document describes the main website elements. These elements can (and will) evolve with time, to ensure the best possible interaction between the project partners and users during the project lifetime.





2 WEBSITE – OVERALL CONCEPTS

The domain name is <u>www.robominers.eu</u> and it was registered via godaddy. The website is hosted in LPRC's servers and it's designed under the *Wordpress* platform. The *Enfold* theme is currently being used.

Analytics – visitors, visits and other relevant parameters are to be continuously monitored through Google Analytics, which is activated in the website since day 1 of the launching.

The basic Robominers website will allow information to be published since the beginning of the project, while the development of a professional website is being developed. It is thus normal that the concepts of the basic and final website might be different.

The basic website will be developed and edited until M6. Updates in both content and design will be pursued. The project image and design elements are currently under development and will be published by M6 in Deliverable 10.3 - Project Stylebook. The website elements will be in accordance to this document.





3 THE BASIC WEBSITE




Figure 2 Website as seen in a mobile browser

Under the Consortium description a new menu called "About Robominers" is to be added with information about the robot, the concept and the design, once this work begins.








Figure 4 Template for the "About Robominers" page
